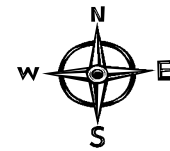

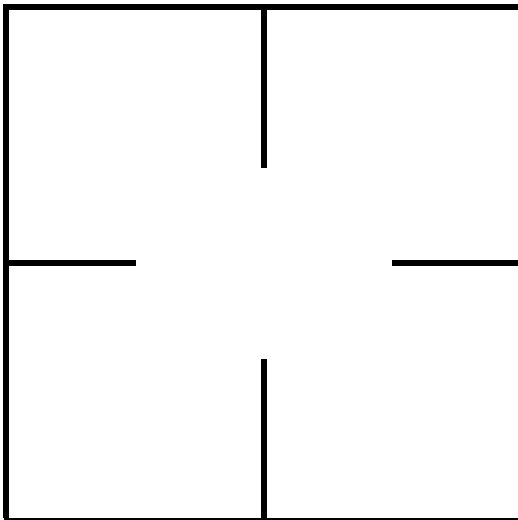

NOTE: Complete plans and specifications must be submitted with application together with plan showing location of proposed work. All the requirements of the Zoning, Subdivision, and WECS Regulations, as revised, and other applicable ordinances and statutory provisions, in so far as they shall apply to the design, erection, location, and use of the structure described above (including electrical and cement work regulations) will be strictly complied with.

If power lines are present at any building site, you will be required to meet the current National Electric Safety Code. Please contact your local utility company.
