



Nance County Board Minutes



September 9, 2025

A meeting of the County Board of Supervisors of Nance County, Nebraska was convened in open session on September 9th, 2025 in the Supervisor's Room, Nance County Courthouse, Fullerton, Nebraska.

Chairman called the meeting to order at 9:00 am with the following members present- Timothy Cornwell, Andrew Ditter, Robert Voichoskie, Ralph Horacek, Steve Crouse and Scott Russell. Absent- Darren Nelson. Also, present is County Clerk, Adrian Chlopek.

Chairman advised those present of the open meetings act and its posting in the Supervisor's Room.

Notice of the meeting was given thereof by publication in the Nance County Journal on September 3rd, 2025.

Notice of the meeting was given to the Board, and a receipt of their acknowledgment is on file in the Clerk's office.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Moved by Voichoskie and seconded by Crouse to approve the agenda.

Moved by Russell and seconded by Ditter to approve minutes of the August 26th, 2025 meeting.

Moved by Horacek and seconded by Crouse to approve all claims submitted.

The Board reviewed and approved the Monthly Fee reports of the County Clerk in the amount of \$3,878.83; Clerk of the District Court in the amount of \$726.00; and County Sheriff in the amount of \$726.00.

The Board reviewed with the various reports a letter from Mike Voichahoske requesting a refund for 2024 personal property, was assessed twice for the same tractor on two different schedules, was already approved at a previous tax list correction. Moved by Russell and seconded by Voichoskie to approve said request.

All department Inventories were reviewed and signed by the Board of Supervisors.

Cornwell discussed the City Contracts with the Sheriff Department. The amounts on each contract were amended, City of Fullerton is \$250,000 and City of Genoa is \$125,000. Moved by Voichoskie and seconded by Russell to approve the amendments to the original City Contracts.

9:22 am moved by Ditter and seconded by Voichoskie to enter into executive session for personnel discussion. 9:33 am moved by Russell and seconded by Ditter to reconvene into regular session. No action taken during executive session.

Moved by Russell and seconded by Crouse to approve Highway Superintendent to advertise for a full-time position for the Road department.

Tony Bernt, Highway superintendent, gives department updates. Have received notice that the 2019 Flood Project is closed with FEMA, will be receiving final payment. 2024 Flood work, continuing with Greg from Speece Lewis, have 15 days to get FEMA all the paperwork for the projects, if not yet completed working on letters of project details and completion dates. Continue to work on FEMA projects from 2024 flash flood. Guardrail on N Emerald crossing Timber Creek was hit, no calls about the damage, will need to be repaired. Have one tree

shredder out. Discussion on advertising for new lowboy trailer and a new pup trailer. Will advertise specific specs needed. Moved by Horacek and seconded Crouse to approve advertising for a lowboy and pup trailer. Have received some good comments on the gravel that is being placed. No start date for the road building remodel as of yet but will be working on getting the portable office here and power and internet to it.

Permit to Construct Utilities on the County right-of-way #4-2025 was received from Telcom Construction for Lumen to plow and utility line from pedestal to landowner's driveway on 555th St. Will be plowing 110'. Discussion held. Moved by Horacek and seconded by Crouse to approve above permit.

Moved by Horacek and seconded by Voichoskie to adjourn.
