The Board reviewed and approved the County Treasurer's Miscellaneous Receipts #26050001 through #26050038 in the amount of \$217,653.37 for the month of April 2026. Moved by Nelson and seconded by Crouse to approve Treasurer's Miscellaneous Receipts for May 2026.

Candace Meredith, Deputy Director for Nebraska Association of County Officials (NACO), presented an overview of legislation from the short session of 2026. She presented legislation that did not pass and items that did pass and will take effect on July 18th, 2026. She also handed out a packet of information that contained information about NACO, the County Profile, benefit services, preferred partners, and National Association of Counties (NACo).

Carrie Rodriguez, Chief Probation Officer for District 5 Probation, talked about how they will not be requesting an increase in the overall budget for District 5 probation of \$273,954.46. The budget is figured by the Census population data and the number of probation cases served in your county comparatively to the other 10 counties they are served by District 5 probation. Nance County's portion will increase by \$328.75 to \$5,670.86; it was \$5,342.11.

Resolution #26-7

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE NANCE COUNT BOARD OF SUPERVISORS to authorize the Nance County Treasurer to make the following transfers in accordance with the adopted 2025-2026 budget: transfer \$225,000.00 from General to Road Fund, \$100,000.00 from General to Sinking Bridge. Moved by Nelson and seconded by Russell to approve the above resolution.

Discussion on payment in the copyright settlement that has been discussed at the past meetings. County Attorney has asked the SRIP Law to add notary acknowledgments to the settlement agreement for both signatures needed. In another email it was requested to have a W9 and 1099 for the payment to be given. Noted that there has been no response from either email. Moved by Nelson and seconded by Crouse to table and hold payment until information requested has been received by County Attorney.

Tony Bernt, Highway Superintendent, gave updates on the road department. Discussed fuel prices on contract; for off road fuel currently \$3.68 could contract for \$3.36 for July 2026 to December 2027 and \$3.14 for January 2027 to December 2027. Moved by Ditter and seconded by Russell to contract 10,000 gallons for July 2026 to December 2027. Roll call: AYES: Voichoskie, Horacek, Russell, Ditter, Cornwell; NAYS: Nelson, Crouse; ABSENT: None. Motion carried. 2024 Flood Project on Valley Road complete, will be working on finalizing paperwork to be sent to FEMA. Will be moving to the Project on N 320th St. and working finishing up other projects for the 2024 Flood. Discussion held on N 200th, have had the Road Right-of-way marked, as county will be working on the right-of-way of N 200th, North of Valley Road a mile. Board would like County Attorney letters letting them know of work to be done in the right-of-way, that may affect fences in right-of-way, etc.

Nance County Township Road Maintenance Agreement setting maintenance rates and standards to be observed were reviewed and discussed. No changes were made and they will be sent out to Townships for reviewing and signing. Moved by Nelson and seconded by Crouse to approve signing and sending out the Township.

Landowner Easement from Jarrid Dubas for a water line, at 53586 N 230th Ave from the driveway west across N 230th. Discussion held. Moved by Russell and Crouse to approve above landowner easement.

SuAnn Gabel, HR/Budget present to discuss budgets. Department head meetings will be at the first meeting in July. No questions at this time from the board on budgets.

Moved by Nelson and seconded by Voichoskie to adjourn the meeting.
